### Safer Internet Day

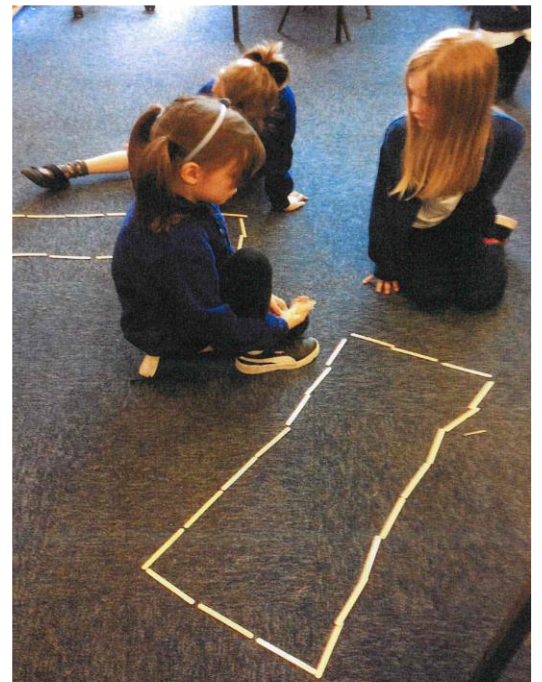
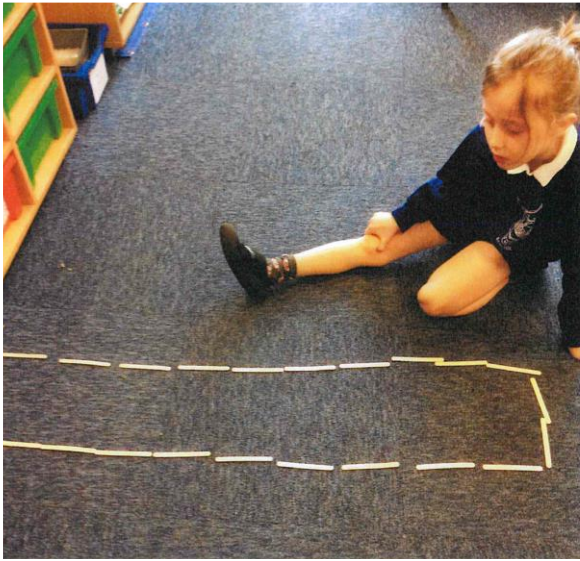
