## Lower Sea Lane Car Park—Message from the owner

We will need time to fill out the necessary details and mark the permits with the relevant identification beforehand to avoid ink smudging creating delays resulting in queues. These permits will need preparing in advance of distribution, which we are planning to carry out at 3pm on Monday 11 June 2018 from the concrete kiosk within the Beach car park. I must stress ONLY those who have applied in advance by email with the complete details will be eligible to collect their permits.

As part of our data control discussions we have acknowledged that we do not actually require the names of the pupils being collected and going forward this will not be requested. However, what we do need is the number of pupils this permit relates to and the year groups they are in currently.

The reason for requesting this information is to ensure that once everyone has left Year 6 we destroy the data and do not contact parents inappropriately going forward. Also to make sure that if you have a pupil at the school after the expiry of any current permit we will contact you in good time to confirm whether or not you would like to renew your permit.

I hope this clarifies our situation and assures you as to our intentions with regards to the additional information requested. We confirm that your data will not be shared, is securely stored, and will only be used with regard to the administration of the pupil parking permit.

This extra time has been allowed due to the lack of information that appears to have reached parents who would like to take advantage of this offer. Please be aware this is the last offer to be made this term.

Payment, where applicable, will be by cash only (no card or cheques please). The fee is £25 (an additional £5 is payable if a second permit is required or a vehicle change requires permit upgrade during the year).

This permit will run from Monday 11 June 2018 until the end of the academic year on 23 July 2019 and is valid from 0840 until 0915 and again from 1515 until 1545 on school days. There is no guarantee of a space. It will be limited by availability.

**If you are only collecting for a Year 6 pupil and need a permit to last until the end of this summer term (25 July 2018) then please send the above details, the permits will be given out at the same time as those above. The cost for the one permit is £10 and £5 for an additional one if required.**

PLEASE park neatly adjacent to the perimeter fence bordering the footpath leading to the bridge over the River Char as this leaves the entrance open to those visiting the car park who are not connected to the school.
